The Gator Dugout Club

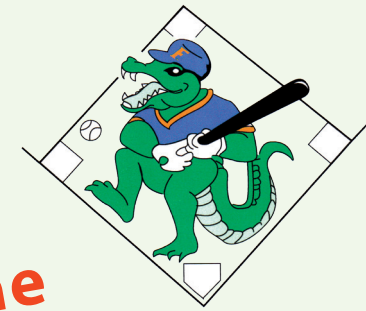

U.S.G.A. rules govern play within format.

- Tournament format is scramble. The foursomes best ball is selected after each shot. Shots will be taken within a club length (4 inches for putts) of selected ball no closer to the hole.
- Players will play from their appropriate tees (ladies, men's, seniors, and now seniors 70+ can go off the ladies tee – if they choose to).
- Rain - Nine holes constitutes a complete round of golf. Rain check will be issued in the event of an incomplete tournament.
- All golfers must register prior to play.
- Proper golf attire is requested: collared shirts, shorts or slacks. NO DENIM please. Soft (non-metal) spiked shoes are required.
- No walk-ons will be allowed.
- Rental clubs are not available.
- Alcohol is not permitted to be brought onto the premises, coolers are not allowed on the cart.
- Bring extra \$\$\$ for Mulligan's and merchandise raffle
- There will be an excellent Silent Auction worthy of \$\$\$.
